Government to Invade Green Lungs for HSR to Avoid Disrupting Urban Areas

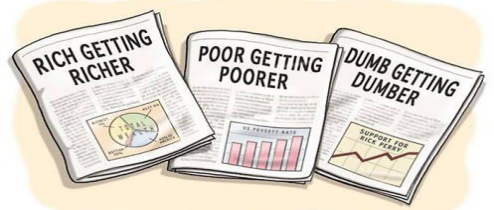
