



Quality of Urban Living is a Key Factor for Urbanites to be Happy

16th Aug: The Lafarge Malaysia Happiness in the City index 2017 survey; the study has found that 43% of the urbanites indicated that the urban living experience was tolerable, 30% of them are happy living in the city, while only 18% indicated they are very happy. Nevertheless, the urbanites mentioned that an integrated transportation, with higher income and job opportunities were the crucial attributes of a liveable city.

The findings of the survey will be used by Lafarge Malaysia in providing insights to help Malaysia create cities which are more sustainable and better connected with more affordable housing.
